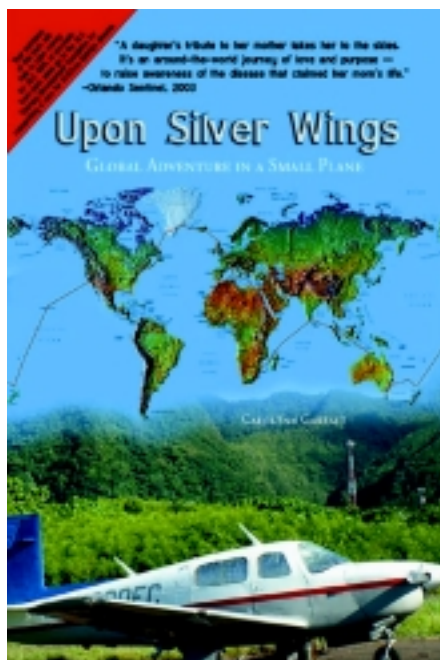
Hope you had a good Holiday with family and friends.
