Tom was in the Navy for 33 years, was a fighter pilot in the Korean War & was a Strike Operations Officer in the Vietnam War. Tom says, "It's hard to get lost anymore...vou have to work at it!" A female pilot from Tanzania, Sogui, who was in ATP training at the Crystal River Airport, joined us for both the meeting/presentation and the lunch afterwards at the local Greek restaurant & she had interesting stories to tell about flying in Africa, especially as one of the few licensed women pilots on the Continent. Our Chapter lost long time member, Eleanor Sharpe. Eleanor had been a member of The Ninety-Nines since 1978. A memorial service for Eleanor was held on Saturday July 21st at the Unity Church of Palm Harbor. Her obituary, which was published on TBO.com on July 15th, is below.

Eleanor Nettie Sharpe, 95, of Largo, formerly of Honolulu, HI, died July 1, 2012. She was born in Buffalo, NY. She is survived by cousins, John (Florence) Sharpe, Karen Sharpe and Don (Denise) Sharpe. Eleanor was an active member of the EAA Experimental Aircraft Association, CAP Civil Air Patrol, and the Post-Polio Survivors Group. She made her solo flight on April 9, 1975, and owned her own Ercoupe into her 80s. Eleanor was a faithful member of Unity Church of Palm Harbor.
